Rules and Regulations

1. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current US Equestrian Federation Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.
2. Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.
3. All horses competing in Federation non-breed restricted licensed competitions with hunter, hunter breeding, jumper, and hunter seat equitation classes (except those activities enumerated in GR901.1, items 1-9) must be properly identified and must obtain a Registration Number from USHFA. Applications for Registration Numbers can be completed online at www.ushja.org or www.usef.org using the Horse Registration application form. The Horse application form is also available from the USHJA or Federation office, or it can be downloaded from the USHJA or Federation website or from competition management.
4. New Canaan Mounted Troop, Inc. shall not be liable whatsoever for any injury or damage to any person or property of any spectator, visitor, exhibitor, attendant or any other persons or animals by reason of any event occurring during the show, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor hold the same as well as their agents, volunteers and/or employees harmless for any accident or loss which may occur by fire or otherwise.
5. The right is reserved to cancel, combine or divide any classes if the entries so warrant, in accordance with USEF Rules HU159 and HU111-116. In addition, the right is reserved to decline any entry, in accordance with USEF Rule GR914, before the start of any competition without being liable for compensation.
6. Course diagrams will be posted at least one hour prior to each class. Management reserves the right to restrict the area of the courtesy circle by a MANDATORY LINE. The same will be indicated on course diagrams and a corresponding barrier will be erected in the ring.
7. All hunter classes are to be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise indicated. Hunter championships will be awarded to two of the four entries scoring the most points over fences; in addition, only these entries will receive full points for the under saddle class. Other championships will be awarded to the two riders scoring the most points in their respective divisions.
8. Riders to be properly attired for all classes. Protective headgear is required at all times when mounted as per USEF regulations.
9. Absolutely NO DOGS or other pets allowed on the grounds.
10. Post entries accepted at no additional fee, if time permits. Early entries appreciated.
11. Every class offered herein which is recognized by the CHJA, NEHC, M&S and other named affiliates will be conducted and judged in accordance with their current rules. Riders, horses and owners must need to be members as outlined in the rules in order to compete and to have points count. Copies of rules, class specifications, and membership applications are available at the secretary's desk.
12. Should any question or dispute arise not provided for in these rules, the same shall be referred to show management whose decision shall be final.
13. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's licensee. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parents, guardians, and or trainers who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties if any include exclusion of the child, parent guardian, and or trainer from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
14. Measurements available by appointment with Fairfield Equine Associates.

Federation Release, Assumption of Risk, Waiver and Indemnification

This document waives important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

I AGREE in consideration for my participation in this Competition – New Canaan Mounted Troop Horse Shows and NEHC to the following:

I Agree that "the Federation" and "Competition" as used herein includes the Licensee and Competition Management, as well as all of their officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers and Federation affiliates. I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse, as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death. ("Harm") I AGREE to hold harmless and release the Federation and the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm of any nature caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm arises or results resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.

I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.

I AGREE to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the Federation and the Competition and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse while at the Competition.

I have read the Federation Rules about protective equipment, including GR801 and if applicable EV114, and I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without penalty, and I acknowledge that the Federation strongly encourages me to do so while WARNING that no protective equipment can guard against all injuries. If I am a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and AGREE to all the above provisions and AGREE to assume all of the obligations of this Release on the child's behalf.

I represent that I have the requisite training, coaching and abilities to safely compete in this competition.
